The Charter night was held in the dining room of the Prescott Hotel and opened with a dinner. Following the main course, a Toast was presented to the Queen and to the Office of the President of the United States. After the dinner the chairman introduced the members at the head table, who consisted of Messrs. Wm. Penneck, chairman of the Board of Governors; Wm. Hole representative of the Montreal Chapter; Geo. Ostiguy vice president; John Fox representing the Grand Council; J.H. Ross, representing the Ontario Chapter from Toronto; E. Schoenherr secretary; Wm. Robinson Treasurer. The chairman our President Bunny Stotesbury then welcomed all out-of-town guests and visitors. The Charter was then presented to the local president by Mr. Ernest Szekely, the National President and by Mr. John Fox, representing Grand Council. Mr J.H. Ross then extended greetings and much success from the Ontario Chapter, followed by the Montreal Chapter representative Mr. Wm. Hole, who along with his greeting presented the Chapter with an ebony gavel with an engraved plate, with the following inscription "Presented to the Ottawa Valley Chapter on the occasion of their Charter Meeting, by the Montreal Chapter A.S.H. & V.E., September 16th, 1952". Acknowledgement was then made by the secretary E. Schoenherr of thirty-three letters and telegrams of congratulations from such as Portland Oregon; Nebraska; Washington; Baltimore; Cleveland; New York; Philadelphia; St. Louis Mo.; Connecticut; Miami; Chicago; Arkansas; Charlotte N.C.; Houston Texas etc. Intermission was then announced.

After the intermission, Mr. Wm. Penneck introduced the most distinguished guest, namely the National President Mr. Ernest Szekely. Mr. Szekely was born in Hungary and educated at the University of Budapest, and at present was the president of the Boyley Blower Co., of Milwaukee Wis. He has been a member of the Society since 1920, president of several Chapters, and has been on the Council or Committees continuously since 1922 up to the present day as President. Mr Szekely then gave a brief history of the Society. He then changed his subject to give some highlights in Air Distribution, principles of air duct design, the laws of fan performance and research work on air flow. Mr Wm. Robinson than thanked the Speaker for his inspiring talk and wished him God's speed in his health. The meeting then adjourned.
