The minutes of the November meeting were adopted as read on a motion by I. Paterson, seconded by G. Richards.

P. Fortier, chapter Treasurer presented an interim financial report which indicated that on the year's operation to this date there was a credit balance of \$27.25 and with the chapter's total balance, including bonds, being \$553.73. Mr. Fortier also mentioned that the chapter membership now stood at 104 members but that to date only 38 members have paid their chapter All members present were urged to pay their dues as soon as possible.

A brief but lively discussion of the proposal put forth by the executive on the question of prepaid meals and dues for \$18.00 followed with the members informed that this was only a proposal designed to improve attendance and avoid the chapter losing money on meals when the attendance fell below the required 50. was emphasized by President Hargreaves that an option would be available to the members if the prepaid scheme was introduced.

President Hargreaves then made a few remarks on the subject of attendance and urged all members present to help in the matter and come forth with any suggestions to the executive.

A motion from the floor was then presented by W.J. Robinson as follows- resolved that the nominating committee for chapter officers consist of the five most immediate chapter past-presidents with any four of the committee to constitute a quorum. Motion was seconded by N. Kirby and carried unanimously.

The regular January Open Forum then followed with Vice-President N. Kirby acting as moderator.
