REGION II NEWSLETTER

I am writing a quick Newsletter to all Region II Chapters to advise you about some of the Chicago highlights that are of importance to our Society and Region.

1. Your present President-Elect and President 1973-74 is Rod Kirkwood.
2. Your new President-Elect is Dave Rickleton.
3. Nominee for Region II Chairman is Don Ledgett, and nominee for new Director-at-Large from Region II is Grant Wilson.
4. Regina CRC and ASHRAE Conference will start 2:00 p.m. Wednesday, May 16, and end May 18. Keynote speaker is to be our deputy minister of Energy who will expound Canada's new energy policy.
5. The National Capital Chapter in Region III has successfully put out a "Manufacturers and Their Representatives" Roster which has not only been in terrific demand but has become a good source of revenue. This is approved by BOD with guidelines to be worked out and submitted. If you are interested I shall include details for the CRC.
6. Remember that George Menzies is Region II Committeeman for Research Fund Program replacing Frank Smith who has had a serious illness.
7. New Bylaws have been approved by BOD to go to the membership for voting soon.
8. BOD approved turning out the Handbook on applications, equipment, systems, and fundamentals grouping starting in 1977.
9. Assistance will be increased by ASHRAE to assist in chapter programming in the form of a Program Committeeman.
10. Don't forget at CRC you will be required to (a) provide 3 names for committeemen for membership, education, research fund raising, and presumably program (I haven't received directive details). While it is intended that committeemen serve more than one term (and each in our region is in his first term), you must put forth these names for me out of caucus because they are there to serve you. If you have found them unsatisfactory, then reappointment will not be made. If they have found you unsatisfactory, they may not wish to stand again, so remember we must have names and they can be in preferential order.
 - (b) Names and bios of all your chapter members willing to serve on various society committees and TC or TGs.
 - (c) Names for turning over to the Nominating Committee for Society officers. The office of Regional Chairman is filled for 3 years, as is one of the two vacancies for Director-at-Large for the next 2 years.
 - (d) THE NEW DELEGATE AND ALTERNATE TO THE NOMINATING COMMITTEE. The past year it was delegate Cliff Morrison, and alternate Jules Olsen.
