

Thank you to all Ottawa Valley Chapter members for your belief and commitment to our chapter.

Every year as the Board of Governors develops the new membership form, we endeavour to structure the membership to encourage new members and retain all our current members. As mentioned in my President's message, we have reduced the Chapter fee this year to \$45 in honour of our 45th Chapter Anniversary. 



