Cost will be \$35 for non-meal plan members.





PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE


Greetings and salutations to all from the President.




ASHRAE OTTAWA VALLEY CHAPTER 1998 ANNUAL GOLF TOURNAMENT

The Annual Golf Tournament was held Thursday, August 13th at the Greyhawk Golf & Country Club.


