Topic: This technical session will review the fundamentals of psychrometrics, the science of moist


air properties, with emphasis on the psychrometric chart. This session will be of interest to students, designers and engineers alike who have had limited exposure to psychrometrics.



### WHAT YOU MISSED

ENERGY EFFICIENCY REVIEW SEMINAR A joint ASHRAE/GBIC/RAIC seminar was held to review the current status of energy efficiency. Topics covered included review of constructed C-2000 buildings, an update on National Energy Code compliance software, analysis of hi-tech versus low-tech energy solutions and an overview of current energy directions in Ontario due to de-regulation.

EVENING SPEAKER Duncan Hill of CMHC gave an overview of ventilation concerns with regard to current practice in Multi-Unit Residential Buildings. Anyone who heard the problems presented will be hard pressed not to investigate alternative means of ventilation on their next multi-unit project.




