Ottawa CRC 2002 from August 22nd to 24th at the Chateau Laurier


Chapter's annual golf tournament at a new location, The Meadows Golf & Country Club.



#### **ASHRAE Research Campaign Kick-Off**


The Research Committee wishes to remind the membership that Golf Tournament profits are donated to ASHRAE Research as part of the kick-off to the campaign.

Cost for the dance alone is a reasonable \$25.00 person; a cash bar will be available.


