PROGRAM: RECENT ASHRAE/NRC SMOKE MANAGEMENT RESEARCH - ATRIA, MALLS,

PLENUM CABLES AND DUCT SMOKE DETECTORS

OVERVIEW: In recent years, NRC has conducted research projects sponsored by ASHRAE to

address issues related to smoke management in buildings. This includes projects to investigate the effectiveness of smoke exhaust systems in atria, sprinklered fires in retail malls, the impact of communication cables in return air plenums and issues related to the application of duct smoke detectors. This presentation will provide an overview of selected projects focusing on the issue that was addressed. The presentation will include a discussion of smoke management issues, the

methods used in the research and the potential impact of the research.

SPEAKER: Dr. Gary Lougheed, Fire Risk Management Program

National Research Council of Canada

Dr. Gary Lougheed is a Senior Research Officer in the Fire Risk Management Program, National Research Council of Canada. He holds a Ph.D. in Physics from the University of Toronto and has more than 26 years research experience in experimental high temperature gas and fluid dynamics and in small- and full-scale fire testing with NRC. Present research activities are directed at smoke movement and smoke management in high-rise buildings and atria. He is Vice-Chairman of ASHRAE TC 5.6, Fire and Smoke Control and a member of the NFPA Smoke

Management Committee.


ASHRAE OTTAWA VALLEY CHAPTER MEETING LOCATION

If you are interested in making a donation to a Student Branch, please contact me directly to make arrangements. We had several handbook donations last year. These are very much appreciated. Thank you.
















Golf Tourney Recap
