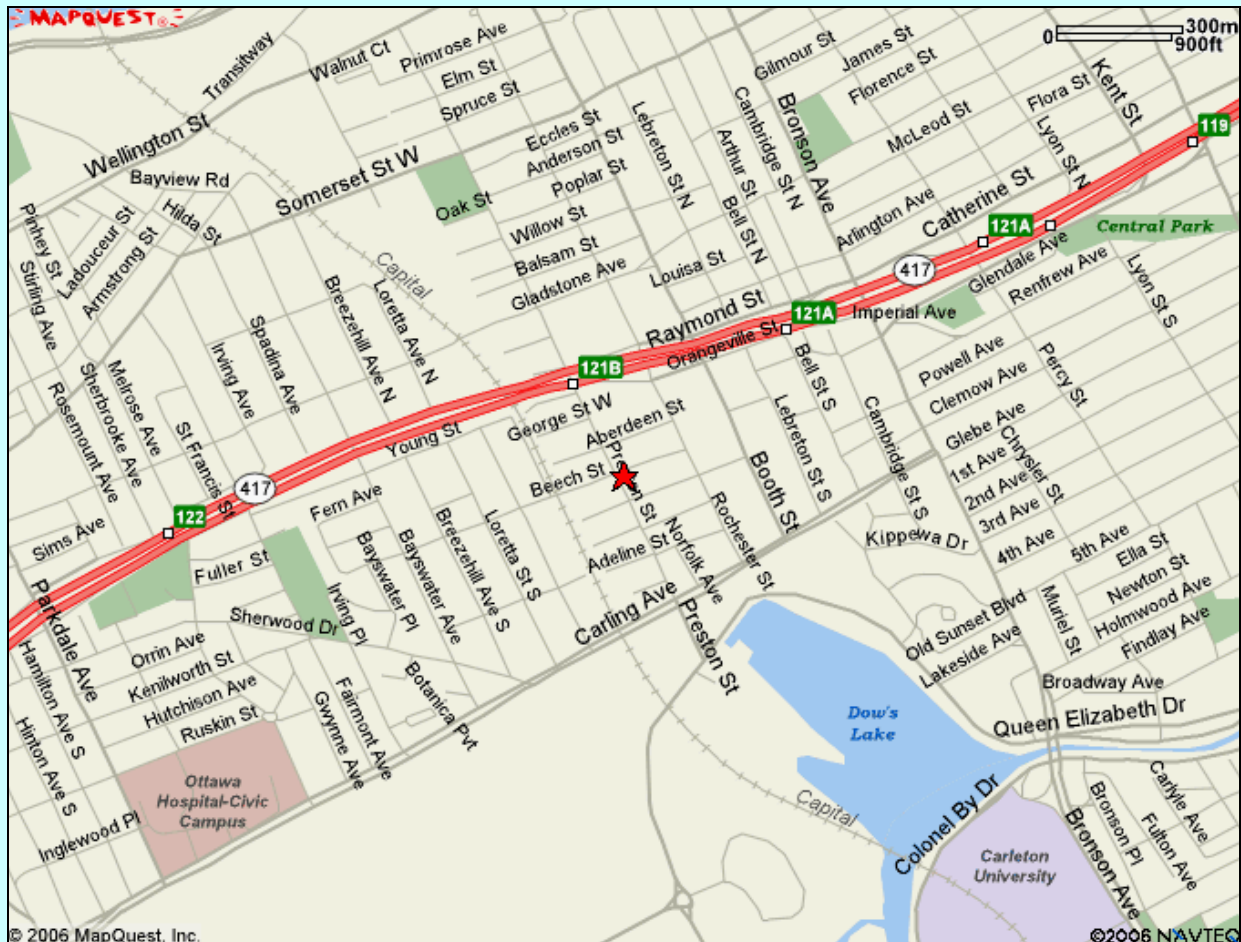
Technical Session (Extended Social)

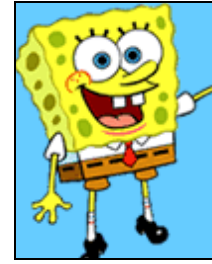
