BACnet (ASHRAE 135) has been available for over 25 years. It has evolved over time and has become the defacto standard for almost all Building Management System specifications. Despite its longevity and popularity, there are many misconceptions as to what **BACnet** is and what it is not. This session provides a primer on the basics of the **BACnet standard**, it's history, a discussion on **interoperability** as well as specific items that could be added to a Controls Specification.

SUMMARY:


